Alpha Code Rules

Single-word names:	If name is longer than four letters, the alpha code is the first four letters of the name.	Ex. <mark>Bobo</mark> link = BOBO
Two-word names:	If there are two words in the name, the alpha code is the first two letters of each word.	Ex. Common Yellowthroat = COYE
Three-words with a hyphenated pair:	If the hyphen is in the first part , the alpha code is the first letter from each hyphenated word and the first two letters from the last word.	Ex. <mark>Y</mark> ellow- <mark>b</mark> illed <mark>Cu</mark> ckoo = YBCU
	If the hyphen is in the last part , the alpha code is the first two letters from the first word and the first letter from each hyphenated word.	Ex. Eastern Wood-pewee = EAWP
Names with three separate words:	If there are three separate words, the alpha code is the first letter from the first two words and then two letters from the last word.	Ex. <mark>G</mark> reat <mark>B</mark> lue <mark>He</mark> ron = GBHE
Names with four words:	If the name has four words, the alpha code is the first letter of each word.	Ex. Northern Rough-winged Swallow = NRWS
